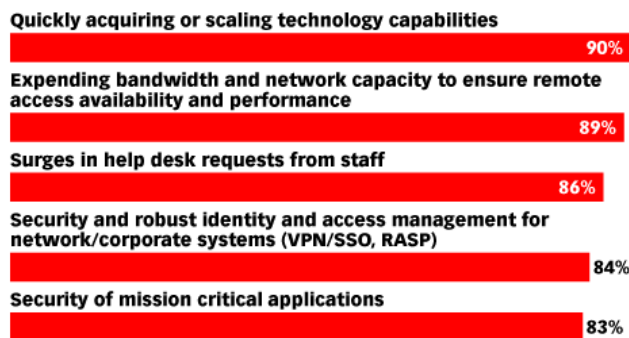

According to May 2020 data from AppDynamics, 90% of IT professionals worldwide cited quickly acquiring and scaling the necessary technology to be a major challenge, while 89% and 86% of

respondents noted expanding network capacity and addressing a surge in help desk requests, respectively.
